- Awards presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place in each division
- Absolute winners will be awarded a Samurai Sword

ECLECTIC KOMBAT PANKRATION GRAPPLING RULES

Please note the following rules apply to all matches. The Eclectic Kombat Pankration Grappling tournaments follow a no point, no Gi, win by submission rule set!

• Ways to win

To win a match in an Eclectic Kombat Submission Tournament is very simple, submit your opponent! If you do not get submitted, the match will extend into a one minute sudden death overtime. In this one minute period the first takedown wins. If no takedown happens this will continue until someone gets a takedown or a competitor gets 3 warnings. Specific examples of rules will be covered at the pre-competition rules clinic.

• Warnings

- -Stalling and avoiding the match for more than 30 seconds
- -Running from your opponent
- -Intentionally leaving the ring area

A warning will be issued for the 1st offense, a warning will be issued for the second offense, and disqualification for the 3rd offense

• Disallowed Submissions, Techniques and Behavior

***All grappling techniques are permitted expect those listed below as illegal techniques.

No-Gi Beginner (& Juniors)

- Twisting Knee Locks
- Heel Hooks
- Knee Bars
- Wrist locks
- Small joint manipulation
- Bicep/calf/thigh slicer
- Forward/reverse cervical cranks, or neck cranks
- Flying Scissors TakeDown

No-Gi Intermediate

- Twisting Knee Locks
- Wrist locks
- Small joint manipulation
- Forward/reverse cervical cranks, or neck cranks

No-Gi Advanced

• Small joint manipulation

All Divisions

- 1. No deliberately trying to injure your opponent. Apply submissions in a slow, gradual manner.
- 2. No striking of any kind including head butts.
- 3. No eye gouging, fish hooking or thumbing.
- 4. No grabbing the ears.
- 5. No hair pulling.
- 6. No small-joint submissions or holds of the fingers or toes.
- 7. No scratching or pinching
- 8. No kicking
- 9. No biting
- 10. No touching the groin area, or eyes.
- 11. No hands, knees or elbows on face.
- 12. No slippery substances allowed on body or clothing
- 13. No hands or elbows to the throat. Forearm to throat is ok.
- 14. No slamming or dropping of an opponent!
- 15. No grabbing an opponent's shorts, singlet or head gear.
- 16. No arguing with officials, cursing or unsportsmanlike conduct, and NO SANDBAGGING

ECLECTIC KOMBAT PANKRATION GRAPPLING RULES

- Competitors with previous amateur MMA fight experience must compete in intermediate or advanced divisions. Fighters with PRO MMA experience must compete in advanced divisions.
- No entry fee refunds after weigh-ins.
- The promoter reserves the right to combine divisions.
- All athletes must be clean and healthy with no communicable diseases. Nails must be trimmed. Long hair must be secured.
- Athletes and coaches will follow all commands from the referee. Referee may disqualify and eject any fighter for failure to follow commands or comply with rules.
- All matches begin from the standing position.
- Fighters who go out-of-bounds will be restarted in the center of the mat in a position determined by the referee.
- Fighters may not grab, hold, or utilize any portion of their opponent's clothing.
- Referee may stop a match at any time if an athlete is in imminent danger of injury.
- An athlete may give-up, tap-out and concede defeat at any time during a match by tapping their hand or foot, two (2) times, on the opponent's body or the mat. An athlete may also give-up verbally by saying, "STOP", to the referee and the opponent.
- Clothing Equipment that is acceptable includes: (must be clean) Fight shorts, board shorts, wrestling singlet, non-metal braces, knee pads, t-shirts, rash guards, mouth guards, groin protective gear and ear guards.
- The referee, tournament director or commissioner, may warn, disqualify and/or eject any competitor or their coach for displaying unsportsmanlike conduct. This includes interference from a competitor's coach/trainer or teammates. The referee has total control of the match and his decisions are final.
- Women will not be permitted to compete in Men's divisions. Men will not be permitted to compete in Women's divisions. Men or Women over age 32 are eligible to compete in their respective divisions, but may also compete in their respective divisions 18-32 yrs old too.



Registration is very simple. Please follow these three simple steps and you will be ready to experience the most exciting grappling experience of your life!

- Step 1: Fill out the REGISTRATION FORM and return the completed form back to our office via mail, or email.
- Step 2: Use our convenient on-line payment system at eknation.com to complete your registration payment. We use PayPal for a secure and safe on-line payment method. You do not have to own a PayPal account to use this system! Easily pay on-line with your Visa / MasterCard and you are set. You may also send your payment in via mail.
- Step 3: Once you have completed the registration form, and made your payment, just show up for weigh-in on Friday night. We will finalize any paperwork and confirm your division.

Divisions & Ring Assignments

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I AM CALLED?

At weigh ins you will be assigned your division based on the selection from your registration form. When your division is called, you must report to the ring and verify you are in the correct division during roll call. The ring coordinator will verify every competitor is in the division that was called. All competitors will be separated by weight, & experience.

At the end of the contest, the referee will raise the winner's hand (decided by Submission). When you win, go to the ring coordinator to ensure that you are properly advanced to the next round. The winning competitor will take a seat and wait to be called back to compete again. This process continues until there is a single winner! This is a single elimination tournament but we do award 3rd place, you may be asked to compete again, even if you lost your prior match. Consult your ring coordinator.

Absolute divisions will consist of all the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} place winners in each respective division. An Absolute tournament will be held for Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced. You must place in your division to get a spot into the Absolute tournament.

Junior, Advanced, Beginner, and Intermediate Division matches will go in that order on the day of competition:
